The principles governing the selection and presentation of historical facts have been the principles adopted in the writing of the Medieval and Modern History, Purely political, dynastic, and military matters have been kept in subordination to religious, moral, intellectual, and social interests. Unity has been impressed upon the narrative by keeping prominent...
