That silver has been, during the past few years, as variable in value a* United State* notes. To this I reply that United States notes have insensibly, though incorrectly, been regarded as promises to pay gold; this regard having been fastened upon them by the fact that, until 1873, the gold dollar was less valuable than the silver dollar, and therefore was the only current coin, and that since 1873 the silver dollar has been demonetized. That being thus regarded as promises to pay gold, United States note* have followed gold, and fluctuated with it, while silver has remained nearly stationary. As gold and greenbacks are not customarily quoted in silver, but, on the...
